An extraordinary concert project, as extraordinary as the journey Gesualdo undertook to northern Italy in 1593 to meet his second wife (after he had murdered his first). On this journey, he also wanted to meet his fellow composers Emilio de Cavalieri and Giovanni Gabrieli to discuss compositional issues.

The programme of this concert is also a journey into the thoughts and feelings of Gesualdo and his time. Gesualdo's 'Tenebrae' with its highly expressive texts, which reflect Gesualdo's attitude to life, are exemplary of this. A feeling characterised by loneliness and madness in the face of the state of the world at the time.
