November 2025 **"Evanesce" - the lost music of Marianna Martines** with Benjamin Wenzelberg, direction // Elisabeth Hetherington, soprano

Marianna Martines, who grew up in a house with Metastasio, and the young, struggling Haydn, was trained by the best music teachers of the time. As a young woman, she attracted attention with her beautiful voice and keyboard playing and would later distinguish herself as an ardent composer of instrumental, choral and vocal music. With so much repertoire, it is a wonder that she is not celebrated today.
